

2021 Virtual Complement UK Training Course and Symposium

Code of Conduct



Complement UK upholds a strong code of conduct to protect and encourage scientists to share their work and unpublished data.

1. No Unauthorized Recording

While some presentations may be recorded by Complement UK organisers with permission from presenters, the conference participants are prohibited from unauthorized recordings including audio, video, photography/screenshots of slides or poster materials, and printed or electronic quotes from papers, presentations, and discussions without written consent of the speakers.

A written approval of the speaker, tutor or poster presenter must first be obtained, prior to quoting or publishing any information presented at a conference in any publication, written or electronic.

Each attendee acknowledges and agrees to these restrictions when registration is accepted and as a condition of being permitted to attend. Each attendee assumes sole responsibility for the protection and preservation of any intellectual property rights in such member's contributions to a conference. 2. Sharing Zoom links with unregistered attendees is not permitted
